## **RITTMAN LIBRARY SUMMER READING PROGRAM**

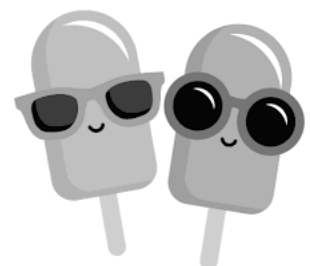
